The bricks in Tribute Park are reserved for past and current Special Olympics Illinois athletes to honor their achievements and accomplishments. Athlete bricks are \$100 and can include first, middle and last name (up to 17 characters), hometown and year engraved.

Families

The relatives of Special Olympics Illinois athletes know firsthand the impact of celebrating achievement. Families are a continual source of support to both the athlete and the Special Olympics movement. Recognition could also be made "In Memory of" or "In Honor of" a family member.

Donors

Throughout the history of Special Olympics, donors have provided the resources to allow programs to be offered at no expense to the athlete or their families. The Donor Wall itself pays tribute to all donors while providing an opportunity to recognize specific gifts to Tribute Park and support for future generations.

Volunteers

Whether you first volunteered for Special Olympics Illinois yesterday or have been a volunteer since its inception, you have been a continual source of support to both the athletes and the Special Olympics movement. While the Volunteer Wall itself honors the role of volunteers, it also provides an opportunity for volunteers to be recognized for their support of the park and support for future generations.

Agencies/Teams

Individual agencies or teams that register, train, and coordinate athlete involvement are vital for continuing to share the Special Olympics experience with more athletes. The pride athletes have in their team and the significance of agency involvement is represented on the Team Walk.

Dedicated on June 17, 2005, Special Olympics Illinois Tribute Park is a one-of-a-kind park designed as a lasting tribute to the enduring spirit of athletes, families, volunteers and donors.

The beautifully landscaped park features stunning life-size bronze statues as well as a specially designed black granite water wall, inscribed with the words "Flame of Hope" that highlights the driving force behind our mission. The Athlete's Oath beside the water wall reminds all who see it of the courage and inspiration that Special Olympics athletes exemplify. Hundreds of brick pavers surround the bronze statue and are reserved for Special Olympics athletes only. Additionally, there are three stone walls paying tribute to Families, Volunteers and Donors.

Tribute Park is a great way to honor and recognize loved ones, someone who has inspired you or made a difference in your life while building a timeless treasure for Special Olympics Illinois. Funds received will sustain the park's future expenses as well as support the development of athlete and family experiences at a national and international level.
