SPECIAL OLYMPICS ILLINOIS ATHLETES TO COMPETE IN STATE BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT ISU & IWU TO HOST OVER 1,800 ATHLETES

BLOOMINGTON, IL. – Friday, March 13 through Sunday, March 15, Special Olympics Illinois athletes will compete in the 2020 State Basketball Tournament. The tournament will take place at Horton Field House of Illinois State University (ISU) & the Shirk Center of Illinois Wesleyan University (IWU).

Over 1,800 Special Olympics Illinois athletes and 150 teams from across the state will compete in the 2020 State Basketball Tournament.

Tentative Competition Times:

- Friday, March 13 10:00 a.m. 5:30 p.m.
- Saturday, March 14 8:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m.
- Sunday, March 15 8:00 a.m. 12:00 p.m.

To compete in the tournament, athletes must have trained for at least eight weeks. Senior/Male and High School teams qualified through one of eight regional tournaments in the state. All teams will play at least two games, and the tournament will be played according to IHSA rules.

The Opening Ceremony will take place in Horton Fieldhouse on Saturday at 7:00 p.m.

Young Athletes have the opportunity to participate in basketball skills on Saturday, March 14 at Illinois State University's Horton Field House.
