Congratulations and welcome to the 2022 Special Olympics Illinois State Golf Tournament! The competition will be held on Saturday, September 10, 2022 and Sunday, September 11, 2022 at Hickory Point Golf Course in Forsyth, Illinois.

Individual Skills, 3-Hole and 6-Hole Divisions / Schedules / Competition:

- Individual Skills, 3-Hole and 6-Hole will take place on Saturday only.
- Athletes will compete in final divisions during Saturday competition and will receive awards upon completion of their event September 10th.
- 3-Hole will be playing a par 3 course and will be playing from silver tee markers.
- 6-Hole will be playing a traditional course and will be playing from gold tee markers.
- Please see the schedule for start times.

Traditional and Unified 9-Hole Divisions / Schedules / Competition:

- Traditional and Unified 9-Hole will take place Saturday and Sunday. All 9-Hole athletes will compete in preliminary divisions for Saturday Competition.
- Athletes / Partners will be re-divisioned into their final divisions for Sunday competition. Please check the website on Saturday evening for those divisions.
- Athletes/Partners competing in 9-Hole competition will receive awards upon completion of the division on September 11th.
- Traditional and Unified 9-Hole golfers, will be playing a traditional course and will be playing from the gold tee markers.
- Please see the schedule for start times.

Registration:

Registration for Registration for Golf will begin at 7:15am on Saturday, September 10th at Hickory Point Golf Course. A short training will be offered to athletes, coaches and caddies at 8:00am

Athlete, Coach and Caddie Training

A short training will be given to athletes, coaches and caddies in the awards area prior to opening ceremony beginning at 8:00am.

Opening Ceremony:

A short Opening Ceremony will be held at Hickory Point at 8:30am prior to the 9 hole shot gun start departure.

Dinner:

Dinner will be offered to athletes and coaches in the form of a voucher to McAlister's Deli. See handbook for more information.

Caddies:

Special Olympics Illinois will not provide caddies for the competition. Athletes are free to bring their own caddie. Caddies must register online **by September 8, 2022:**

Golf Carts

- No carts will be allowed for athletes/unified partners unless previously approved by the Tournament Director.
- No carts will be available for spectator rental.

Free State Golf Spectator Live Scoring Instructions

- Please enter iWanamaker.com into your google search and open
- Register if you don't already have an account:
 - Create user name using your email
 - Password must contain 1 capital letter, 1 number and a character
- To sign in:
 - Click "Sign In" in upper right
 - Enter user name and password
 - Enter the 4 digit code sent to you via email
- To Find Event and Athlete:
 - Click "Search" in upper right
 - Type "SOILL" into the search box and press "Search"
 - Click "View More Results" on bottom right of screen
 - 4 events should pop up
 - Click on event you would like to follow
- Watch Scores:
 - Leaderboard listing all athletes in that event will pop up
 - You will need to click refresh button (small circle with arrow above scores) to make sure you have the most up to date scores
